- 1. All participants will receive color-coded price tags. Please do not use straight pins, but use safety pins on your items instead. You may also use a tag gun or make your color tags into strings.
- 2. Price your items in increments of whole dollars for convenience of making change.
- 3. You do not have to place your name on items and may use your own code to track your personal item inventory.
- 4. Please deliver all boutique items in plastic containers. The Traditional Arts Building at the fairgrounds will have wet floors if it rains.
- 5. The boutique set up will be Friday, July 28 at 11 am. Make your deliveries to the Traditional Arts Building at 11 am. Boutique take down will be on Saturday, August 5 at 9 pm. If you are not able to pick up your inventory on Saturday evening, please make arrangements to have someone pick them up for you.
- 6. The Evening Star Quilter's Guild is not responsible for any missing items.
- 7. Each boutique participant's sales items will be totaled and ten percent (10%) will be deducted and given to the Guild.
- 8. An ESQG check will be written to each participant with the net amount of their sales from fair week.
- 9. Fair boutique working hours will be 12 noon to 5 pm each day. Irene Compton will work the evening hours, 4 pm to 9 pm.
