

BALL AND CHAIN

Color #1 Dark

Color #2 Light

Cutting: Color # 1 dark (8) - 2 1/8" squares
(21) - 1 7/8" squares

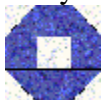
Color #2 light (4) - 4 1/2" squares
(8) - 2 1/8" squares
(8) - 1 7/8" squares

Sewing: - Stack dark and light 2 1/8" squares RST.
- Draw a line from corner to corner.
- Sew 1/4" from drawn line.
- Cut apart on the drawn line.
- Press towards the dark.
- You will have 16 squares.

Sew center nine patch (chain unit) by making three rows of color #1 & 2 - 1 7/8" squares as shown above. Using scant 1/4" seams, and alternating pressing directions by row.



Sew the (ball unit) as shown above, using color 1 & 2 1 7/8" squares plus corner half squares. Again sew scant 1/4" seams, and alternating pressing directions by row. Make four units like this.



Join the units into three rows to complete the block alternating pressing directions by row.
