How to Enter Checklist

- Completed entry form, one for EACH entry. Please print clearly or email.
- All entries must be clean, free of pins, pet hair, and smoke.
- All entries must have a label sewn to the lower left-hand corner on the back of the quilt.
- Place each entry in a pillowcase with your name and address on each case. A picture of the quilt attached to the pillowcase is very strongly suggested.
- All entries must be delivered to Barbara Contini's house, **Monday July 21, 2008 by 5:00pm**. This is the deadline; quilts will be hung on Saturday July 26th. Sharon Kubich will be typing the information sheets that hang on each quilt which is the reason we need to have the quilts to Barbara by 5:00 on the 21st.
